

BUY A BRICK

Make a lasting tribute to family and friends through the brick fundraising campaign, sponsored by the **Polish American Heritage and Community Foundation (PAHCF)** and the **Polish American Citizens Club (PACC)**. **Net proceeds from each brick sold go directly to maintaining the park and to support college scholarships through the PAHCF.**

The bricks are 4" x 8" and can be engraved with up to three lines, 15 characters per line. Bricks can be purchased in your name or the name of a friend or family member; in celebration of a birth, graduation, wedding or anniversary; in honor of a soldier or veteran; or in memory of someone you love. Cost of each brick is \$100.

Bricks will be on sale until March 2020. Bricks will be installed in Pulaski Park in front of the Casimir Pulaski Memorial Statue in spring 2020, just in time for Polish Fest Boston (scheduled for Sunday, May 3, 2020).
